Rock County Public Health Department Provides Instructions for the Remainder of Phase 1A Vaccinations

The Rock County Public Health Department recognizes that many people eligible for Covid-19 vaccination in Phase 1A are not affiliated with an approved vaccine provider and may not know how to receive a vaccine. Therefore, we have instituted a system to assist those remaining in Phase 1a to request their Covid-19 vaccinations.

Those eligible for a vaccine under Phase 1A are healthcare workers and long term care facility residents. If you or your organization qualify for Phase 1A and want to request vaccination, follow these steps:

1. Visit the Rock County Public Health Department website at www.co.rock.wi.us/publichealth and **click on the Coronavirus link.**
2. Click on and Fill out the COVID-19 PHASE 1A Agency Vaccine Request Form. **To expedite the process, please designate one person from your organization to complete this form, if possible.**
3. If you do not have internet access or are otherwise unable to complete the form online, you can call 608-352-6727 for assistance.
4. **Be prepared to provide information about your organization, including the number of people who would like to be vaccinated.**

Those who complete this form and are eligible to be vaccinated will receive follow-up instructions from a vaccine provider. **If you do not qualify, you will not be contacted and will need to request a vaccination again when you are eligible or further instructions are available.**

As of January 18, 2021, police and fire personnel are also eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. Vaccine providers should be contacting these organizations to schedule vaccinations.

People age 65 and over are also eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. Healthcare providers should be reaching out to their existing patients with further instructions. Those without a regular healthcare provider should watch for updates from pharmacies or other vaccine providers.

Rock County is committed to transparent and equitable access to the Covid – 19 vaccine for our community. As we receive information from local healthcare providers, pharmacies, and state and federal partners, this will be shared with the community through media outlets. Be sure to watch the news and follow the Rock County Public Health Department’s social media and website for updates.
