Dear Clinton Community School District Families,

The health of our students, staff, families, communities and most vulnerable is of utmost importance and we support all efforts to reduce the impact of COVID-19. The Clinton Community School District just received notification from Governor Tony Evers ordering the closure of Wisconsin schools.

Clinton Community School District, along with many area schools, has decided to close beginning Monday, March 16, 2020 and will remain closed pending guidance from our local, state, and federal health officials. Current guidance states the earliest return date would be April 6, 2020. The date of reopening is subject to change pending further information.

Beginning Monday, March 30th, all Clinton Community School District schools will implement alternative learning models such as a virtual learning environment. These learning models will be shared directly from your student's school next week.

Concern over COVID-19 can make children anxious. The National Association of School Psychologists offers some valuable advice [at this link](#) on teaching children positive preventive measures, talking with them about their fears, and giving them a sense of some control over their risk of infection can help reduce anxiety.

This situation is unprecedented. We will continue to monitor and communicate information promptly as the situation continues to evolve.
